In pursuance of the Section 53 of the AP Reorganization Act, 2014, Separate GENCO for the State of Telangana has been created vide G.O.1st cited. At para 7 of the said G.O. it has ordered that pending transfer of employees, all staff working at various plants/locations and Training Institute at Dr.NTTPS as on effective date (02.06.2014) shall continue to work there and draw their salaries accordingly. As per the orders issued vide G.O.2nd cited, Lower Sileru Hydro Electric Scheme has been transferred to APGENCO.

2. AP Power Utilities have made all efforts to resolve the request of Telangana Native Employees to relieve them. But due to the effect of pending litigation, and pending finalization of modalities under Section 82 of the AP Reorganization Act, 2014 the said request of Telangana Native employees who have been working with AP Power Utilities under order to serve is found to be not feasible. In fact the Management of AP Power Utilities have no powers to interfere with service conditions of employees working with it, pending final bifurcation of employees.

3. 'Nativity' as a criterion for allocation of employees of the IX Schedule Institution cannot be endorsed as of now by either of the States pending crystallization of modalities for distribution of employees envisaged under section 82 of the AP Reorganization Act, 2014. The present provisional allocation is only for service delivery and in consonance with 'Order to Service' principle. Therefore, the relieving on your own accord without reference to the Management may not be understood as deemed acceptance by APGENCO/APTRANSCO as the same is unknown to Service Law.

4. In the representation cited, Sri/Smt **"as listed in the annexure"** has informed **that you are getting relieved from APGENCO with immediate effect i.e. "as listed in the annexure"** on your own for the reasons stated therein which amounts to relinquishment of right as a Member of Service of APGENCO in terms of APSEB Service Regulations as adopted.
